14 acres 3 roods 5 perches in the parish of Woodford let to General Arbuthnot on a lease for 21 years from 6th April 1851 at the annual rent of £40.0.0

3 roods in the parish of Denford let to William Baby from year to year at the annual rent of £2.0.0
