Church Hall

Mrs Horrell organised a Bacon and Egg Supper on Thursday 19th November, the proceeds of which were to be allocated to the Church hall account which owes £200 the cost of the new central heating in the hall. The event was not as well patronised as the workout into it by the ladies concerned warranted – which was a pity. However, the proceeds amounted to £4.0.0 reducing our first annual repayment to £38.0.0. Our thanks are due to Mrs Horrell for this effort, to the ladies who helped her and to all who gave eggs etc.

It will be generally acknowledged that the Church Hall meets a need in the village, but it is subsidised by the Parochial Church Council. Lettings are not of sufficient frequency to render it financially stable and certainly not to permit the expenditure of such a large sum. We therefore appeal to all organisations which enjoy the benefits of the new system to either help us to repay this heavy deficit either by direct contributions or efforts on one sort or another. The sooner the loan is repaid the happier we will be.
